All: "Let us burst asunder their fetters.

Let us cast off from <u>us</u> their chains." He who sits in the <u>heav</u>ens laughs; the LORD derides <u>and</u> mocks them.

Choir: Then he will speak in his anger,

his rage will strike  $\underline{\text{them}}$  with terror. "It is I who have appoint  $\underline{\text{ed}}$  my king

on Sion, my holy mountain."

All: I will announce the decree of the LORD: The LORD said to me,

"You are my Son. It is I who have begotten <u>you</u> this day.

Ask of me and I will give you the nations as <u>your</u> inheritance,

and the ends of the earth as your possession.

Choir: With a rod of iron you will rule them;

like a potter's jar you will shatter them."

Choir: My God, my God,

why have <u>you</u> forsaken me? Why are you far <u>from</u> saving me, so far from my <u>words</u> of anguish?

All: O my God, I call by day and you do not answer;

I call by night and I find <u>no</u> reprieve.

Yet you, O God, are holy,

enthroned on the praises of Israel.

Choir: In you our forebears <u>put</u> their trust;

they trusted and you <u>set</u> them free. When they cried to you, they <u>es</u>caped;

in you they trusted and were not put to shame.

All: But I am a worm and no man,

scorned by everyone, despised by the people.

All who see me <u>de</u>ride me;

they curl their lips, they toss their heads:

Choir: "He trusted in the LORD, <u>let</u> him save him;

(omit 2 and 3)

All: Yes, it was you who took me from the womb,

entrusted me to my <u>moth</u>er's breast. To you I was committed from birth;

from my mother's womb, you have been my God.

Choir: Stay not far from me;

trouble is near, and there is no one to help.

Many bulls have <u>sur</u>rounded me, fierce bulls of Bashan <u>close</u> me in.

All: Against me they open wide their mouths,

like a lion, rend<u>ing</u> and roaring. Like water I am <u>poured</u> out, disjointed are <u>all</u> my bones.

Choir: My heart has be<u>come</u> like wax,

it is melted within my breast.

Parched as burnt clay is my throat, my tongue cleaves to my jaws.

You lay me in the dust of death.



All: For dogs <u>have</u> surrounded me;

a band of the wicked besets me.

They tear holes in my hands and my feet; I can count every one of <u>my</u> bones.

They stare at me and gloat.

Choir: They divide my clothing among them,

they cast lots for my robe.

But you, O LORD, do not stay a<u>far</u> off; my strength, make <u>haste</u> to help me!

All: Rescue my soul <u>from</u> the sword,

my life from the grip of the dog. Save my life from the jaws of the lion, my poor soul from the horns of wild bulls.

Choir: I will tell of your name to my kin,

and praise you in the midst of the assembly.
